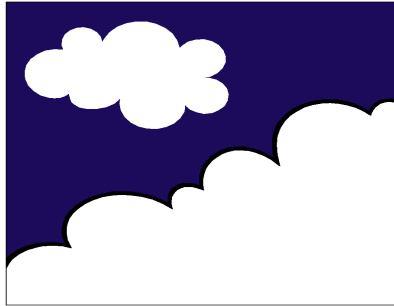

In my twenty years of work in the area of personal and family counseling, I have had demonstrated to me over and over again the importance of that picture. I have come to believe that every person can benefit by first clarifying that picture at a conscious level and then examining that picture to correct any distortions. In the final analysis, those God view distortions feed unhappiness and destroy relationships with such caustic emotions as guilt, hopelessness, and despair (as opposed to those success nurturing attitudes of forgiveness, hope, and endurance).

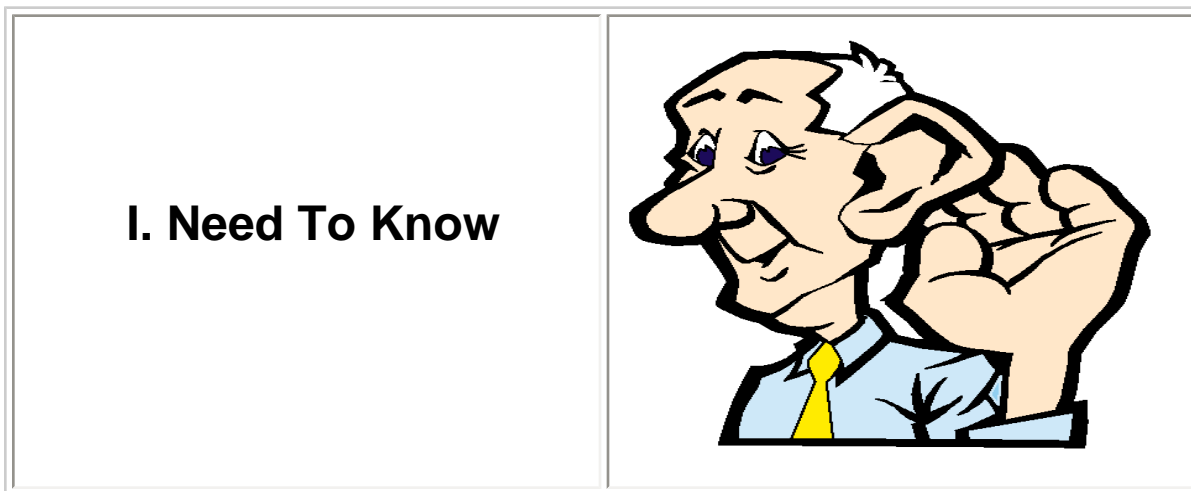

"But I tell you the truth; it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you.

When He comes, He will convict the world of guilt in regard to sin and righteousness and judgment. . . I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear.
